

# IACCT Mission

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are as follows:

1. (a) To establish and maintain a place of worship for the people who have religious persuasions of Asian Indian origin. This place of worship will be used for Puja, Bhajans, Satsang, and other religious gatherings and prayers.
- (b) To preserve and promote the rich cultural and social traditions of India and to foster and enrich the same in southwest Michigan. This will be accomplished by:
  - i) Promoting Indian culture and values through appropriate educational activities.
  - ii) Promoting the understanding of all the religions of the world, and developing and maintaining harmonious relations among them.
  - iii) Providing charitable services to the local and world community.
- (c) To buy, own, manage, receive, administer, lease, and mortgage real estate, personal property, and other assets for use in connection with the objectives specified in 1(a) and 1(b) above.
- (d) To conduct any and all such activities and exercise any and all such powers as are necessary to the achievement and furtherance of the objectives of the corporation set forth herein.
